Completed work and upcoming schedule

The station and lifts are now open for use and the new and improved accessibility features are complete:

- two new lifts connecting the platforms to the existing footbridge and commuter car parks
- ✓ a new accessible parking space and kiss and ride space in both commuter car
 parks
- ✓ a new pedestrian crossing across the northern commuter car park
- ✓ relocation of the existing southbound bus stop on Narara Valley Drive
- √ formalised Boarding Assistance Zones on each platform
- ✓ upgraded CCTV and lighting for improved safety and security.

Finishing work

Minor finishing work will take place in the coming weeks including additional light installation, painting, and finalising the new Boarding Assistance Zone canopy on Platform 1. Work will be carried out during standard construction hours between **7am** and **6pm** from **Friday 15 October** to **Tuesday 30 November 2021**.

Work on the new accessible path and stairs from the station to Narara Valley Drive will also be carried out in the coming weeks during standard construction hours and is due to be open for use by late October. Please use the lifts located at the Narara Valley Drive entrance and Goonak Parade entrance to access the Station while the new ramp is being constructed.

Equipment to be used includes a crane, powered hand tools and ladders.

Our crews will comply with all NSW Health COVID regulations while they carry out these works, with traffic control on site for driver and pedestrian safety.
