


Transport Access Program Narrabri Station Upgrade Community notification



Narrabri Key Features Plan

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Narrabri Station

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Narrabri Train Station. This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe, and accessible infrastructure.

Contract award

Since receiving planning approval in October 2021, the contract for the construction of Narrabri Station upgrade has been awarded to North Construction. Works are expected to begin late November 2021. Thank you to everyone who provided feedback on the proposed concept design. Your feedback has helped the project team to understand what is important to customers and the community.

Project overview

As part of this program, Narrabri Station will be upgraded to provide an accessible station for people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage. The upgrade will include:

- upgrade of the existing ramp to create an accessible path from the car park
- one accessible car space
- a formalised bus stop with a vehicle turning path
- modifications to the waiting room
- a new family accessible toilet
- upgraded platform seating
- a new boarding zone and tactile indicators on the platform
- · improvements to wayfinding and lighting.

Construction is due to commence late in November 2021 and we anticipate it will take approximately six months to complete the Transport Access Program works.

A temporary construction compound will be required for laying down equipment and machinery, parking plant and vehicles, and storage of materials. The primary compound area is to be located west of the station area in the existing gravel car park adjacent to the station building. A secondary laydown area is proposed in the existing gravel area located south of the commuter car park and accessed via Logan Street. This area will be used if additional storage area or vehicle parking is required. The site compound will result in the temporary loss of up to six car parking spaces during construction.

Vehicles and equipment to be used include delivery and concrete trucks, concrete pumps, concrete saws, cranes, excavators, generators, and hand tools.

Working hours

Construction work is proposed to be undertaken during standard construction hours:

- 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday
- 8:00am to 1:00pm Saturday
- No works on Sundays or public holidays

Works undertaken outside standard hours would be subject to prior approval from TfNSW and in consultation with the local community.
