Niagara Park Station Upgrade

Project Update

June 2021

Construction activities in June includes:

- installing underground services in the commuter car parks to supply power to the new lifts and upgraded services
- installing lift components inside the three new lift shafts
- installing a new accessible pathway between the station and local shopping centre including a new bus stop located closer to the local shopping centre
- resurfacing Washington Avenue and Kathleen Morreau Commuter Car Parks
- resurfacing the platform and installing new tactile along the platform edge
- constructing lift entry forecourts in Washington Avenue and Kathleen Morreau Commuter Car Parks
- installing lift entry screens all all three lifts.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, dump trucks, vacuum trucks, surveying equipment, delivery trucks, concrete trucks, scaffolding, cranes, elevated work platforms, power and hand tools.

Weekend work – Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 June 2021

From **7pm Friday 11 June until 2am Monday 14 June 2021** work will be carried out **continuously** during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when trains are not operating.

Traffic controllers will assist pedestrians using the footbridge while the crane intermittently operates during this time.

The weekend work will involve:

- installation of lift shaft structural steel roof elements onto the new lifts
- resurfacing Platform 1.

Equipment to be used includes delivery trucks, large mobile cranes, elevated work platforms, dump trucks, excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, mobile lighting towers, power and hand tools.

The construction equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work.

Temporary closure of both commuter car parks

During the weekend work, both commuter car parks will be temporarily closed. Washington Avenue Commuter Car Park will **close** from **5am Friday 11 June 2021 until 11:59pm on Monday 14 June 2021** and Kathleen Morreau Commuter Car Park will **close** from **7am Saturday 12 June 2021 until 11:59pm on Monday 14 June 2021**. This is to allow for the car park resurfacing and linemarking work. Pedestrian access to the station and existing bus stop on Railway Crescent will be maintained.

Temporary access changes and permanent bus stop relocation

Until **late 2021** work to upgrade the footpath between the Washington Avenue Commuter Car Park and the new bus stop location on Washington Avenue will be underway. Please continue to use the existing bus stop while we carry out this work.

Pedestrian and vehicle access will be maintained at all times. Please follow signage in place to access the temporary footpath.

Standard construction hours

Standard construction hours are now **7am to 6pm every day**. This is to facilitate social distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.

For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

The community will be kept informed about the project, including upcoming work via notifications that will be distributed to nearby residents.
