


Transport Access Program

Niagara Park Station Upgrade



The upgrade to Niagara Park Station is progressing well with the power supply upgrade closer to completion and all three lift shafts to be installed by Thursday 29th April.

Upcoming work

Construction activities in May will include:

- installing underground services in the commuter car parks to supply power to the new lifts and upgraded services
- installing lift shafts for the new lifts located within Washington Avenue
- installing a temporary accessible pathway between the station and local shopping centre to provide an alternative route during construction of the permanent footpath.
- Installing a new accessible pathway between the station and local shopping centre including a new bus stop located closer to the local shopping centre.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, dump trucks, vacuum trucks, surveying equipment, delivery trucks, concrete trucks, scaffolding, cranes, elevated work platforms, power and hand tools.

Temporary access changes and permanent bus stop relocation

Until **late 2021** work to upgrade the footpath between the Washington Avenue Commuter Car Park and the new bus stop location on Washington Avenue will be underway.

This work includes:

- installing a temporary accessible footpath between the station car park and the Washington Avenue footpath
- upgrading sections of the Washington Avenue Commuter Car Park drainage
- construction of the new accessible footpath between the new bus stop location and the station.
- permanent relocation of the bus stop (from June 2021).

Please continue to use the existing bus stop while we carry out this work.

Pedestrian and vehicle access will be maintained at all times. Please follow signage in place to access the temporary footpath.

Temporary changes to Kathleen Morreau Road Commuter Car Park

Approximately 10 car spaces are temporarily unavailable until August 2021 to allow for the safe delivery of the station upgrade work within the Kathleen Morreau Road Commuter Car Park. The remaining spaces will continue to be available for customers to use.

Standard construction hours

Standard construction hours are now **7am to 6pm every day**. This is to facilitate social distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.

For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Keeping the community informed

The community will be kept informed about the project, including upcoming work via notifications that will be distributed to nearby residents.
