Ourimbah Station Upgrade

Project Update February 2021



Upcoming work

Construction on the Ourimbah Station Upgrade is progressing well with demolition work underway during January.

Activities will continue in February including:

- installation of underground services under the stairs between Platform 2 and the WWII Memorial Garden
- installation of concrete slabs and kerbs within Shirley Street Commuter Car Park
- demolition work to upgrade the Pacific Highway station forecourt
- installation of underground drainage in the station precinct
- installation of underground electrical services in Shirley Street Commuter Car Park to supply power to the new lifts
- work to raise the ground level for the new ramp to Platform 1.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, jack hammers, concrete trucks and pumps, delivery trucks, power and hand tools.

Temporary work area at Pacific Highway station forecourt

From **Monday 15 February 2021 until mid 2021** access to and from the station from Pacific Highway will change while work is carried out to upgrade the station forecourt between the Pacific Highway and Platform 2. Access to the station and the footbridge from Pacific Highway will be via Platform 2. Signage will be in place to assist customers with this change. Please see the map overleaf for more information.

Temporary ramp from Shirley Street Commuter Car Park to Platform 1

From January until June 2021 the access ramp to Platform 1 will be temporarily closed while we carry out upgrades on the ramp. Access to Platform 1 will be via a temporary access ramp 30m north of the station building. Signage will be in place to assist customers with this change. The stairs will remain open during this time. Please see the map overleaf for more information.

Temporary changes to Shirley Street Commuter Car Park

Up to 11 car spaces will be temporarily closed until **late March 2021** to enable power supply upgrade work to continue. Signage will be in place to assist motorists with the change.

One of two bike racks will be temporarily unavailable during the work. The bike storage facility will remain available for use. Cyclists are able to use the relocated bike rack and bike storage facility within the Shirley Street Commuter Car Park. Signage will be in place to assist cyclists with these changes. Construction hours

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

- Temporary work zone at station forecourt. Station access available around work area to stairs via Platform 2 from Monday 15 February.
- Pedestrian access route to/from stairs and Platform 2 while work at station forecourt underway.
