Ourimbah Station Upgrade

Project Update

June 2021

Construction on the Ourimbah Station Upgrade is progressing well. Work will continue in June and includes:

- installing underground drainage in the station precinct and at the rear of Platform 2
- pouring new concrete slabs and laying sandstone pavers within the western forecourt
- fitout of the new undercover waiting area on Platform 1
- fit out work within the lift shafts
- constructing the accessible ramp to the Platform 2 waiting room
- station precinct power supply upgrade.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, jack hammers, concrete trucks and pumps, delivery trucks, power and hand held tools.

Weekend and night work – Saturday 12 until Tuesday 15 June 2021

To ensure the safety of customers and workers, work will be carried out during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when trains are not operating. Work will be carried out **continuously** from **6am Saturday 12 June until 2am Tuesday 15 June 2021**.

The pedestrian footbridge from the Pacific Highway to the station car park will be closed from **8am Saturday 12 June until 8pm Sunday 13 June**. A free shuttle bus will be in operation during this time helping members of the public travel from one side of the station to the other. Traffic controllers will assist pedestrians whilst the shuttle bus is operational.

The weekend work will involve:

- the operation of equipment on Platform 2 to remove the existing asphalt surface, install new asphalt and new tactiles along the platform.
- installation of new tactiles on Platform 1.
- removal of the temporary ramp currently installed in the Shirley Street Commuter Car Park to access Platform 1
- station precinct power supply upgrade.

Equipment to be used includes delivery trucks, elevated work platforms, dump trucks, excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, mobile lighting towers, power and hand tools.

The equipment will be positioned as far away from residential areas as possible with regular respite periods during noisy work.
