Petersham Station Upgrade

## **Community notification**

August 2021

Construction on the Petersham Station Upgrade project was paused from Monday 19 July, in line with Public Health Orders. Since this time, our construction sites have been closed, with minimal staff onsite for permitted safety and security activities.

We are making arrangements for our work activities to safely recommence as detailed in this notification. Should restrictions change based on advice by the NSW Government, which may impact the timing of our work, the community will be notified. The safety and wellbeing of our workforce and the wider community is our highest priority. Our workers and worksites follow NSW Health's COVID-19 requirements and will continue to do so.



## **Upcoming work**

Construction for the Petersham Station Upgrade is progressing well with continued upgrades to the Trafalgar and Terminus Street station entrances, and station platforms carried out in July. Construction activities will continue in August, including:

- upgrade to electrical and communication services on the platform and footbridge
- installation of the internal lift cars
- finishing work on the new lift shafts, lobby area, canopy landings and platform building
- pavement work and installation of seating, signs and line marking on Terminus and Trafalgar Streets
- road works and installation of new pram ramps on Terminus Street
- installation of new wayfinding signage.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, tipper and delivery trucks, concrete pumps, concrete trucks, truck-mounted crane, rollers, and power and hand tools.

#### **Road work on Terminus Street**

Road resurfacing work will be carried out in front of the station's new forecourt area on Terminus Street in August. **This work is expected to take about two days.** 

For work to be completed safely, **Terminus Street between Railway and Palace Streets, will be closed over the two days.** Access for local residents only will be provided from Palace Street. A detour via Brighton Street will be in place for all other traffic. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.



## Tree planting

Eleven new street trees will be planted on Terminus, Railway, Trafalgar and Palace Streets and The Avenue in August 2021.

The trees, which include Water Gums, Tuckeroo, Ivory Curl Flower Trees, and Zelkova Serratas (Green Vase), will help offset any trees removed as part of the station upgrade, help increase the amount of shade in the area and improve the local environment for the community.

Planting is expected to take around two weeks to complete, and will include cutting concrete for new tree pits, soil improvement, timber tree guard installation and mulching.

## **Parking changes on Terminus Street**


We are putting in the final touches to complete the new station forecourt on Terminus Street.

Approximately seven parking spaces will be removed on the station side to enable the extension of the new station forecourt on Terminus Street, providing an accessible path of travel to the new lift from the new accessible parking and Kiss and Ride spaces.

**Approximately seven parking spaces on Terminus Street**, opposite the station entrance will also be removed to ensure two-way traffic can be maintained along Terminus Street.

'No Stopping' signs are proposed to be installed at these locations to ensure the safe passage of vehicles on Terminus Street. Please refer to the map below for more information.

We will notify the community prior to implementing these parking changes.



#### **Construction hours**

To support the construction industry and continue the delivery of important infrastructure, the NSW Government has introduced new rules allowing construction sites to operate on weekends and public holidays.

Standard construction hours are from 7am to 6pm every day, including public holidays. These changes have been made to facilitate physical distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.

We understand extending construction hours to include weekends and public holidays may cause disruption, however all efforts will be made to minimise impacts where possible and ensure strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management are adhered to.
