### Project update

2021 has been extremely busy for the Redfern Station Upgrade – New Southern Concourse project team. It feels like only yesterday we received Planning Approval from the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment, but that was in December and over six months ago. Since then, we have been working hard to deliver this important project so everyone can enjoy access to all ten above ground platforms at Redfern Station.

Some of our key achievements to date include:

- 2280 tonnes of concrete poured
- 800m+ of high voltage cable relocated on Platform 10
- 67 columns or piles built
- 63 tonnes of steel reinforcement installed
- 6 hoarding structures installed across Platforms 1 to 10

We have also established two site compounds, one at Marian Street and one in North Eveleigh. These areas have greatly improved access for the project team and are providing the space we need for the safe operation and movement of plant, equipment and materials. This is where we will keep the bridge beams once we take delivery of them. The crane will also operate from here to assist with the delivery of materials, plant and other components for the footbridge.

Other work underway includes the removal of the existing internal fitout of 125-127 Little Eveleigh Street, locating services in the ground and various excavation activities. Preparation work for the Little Eveleigh Street car park is also underway and preparation of the southern building on Platform 1 has commenced in advance of its relocation later in the year.

The project team thanks you – residents, businesses and the broader community for your patience and support as this important project and its infrastructure is delivered.

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## Reducing our footprint through carbon offsets

Did you know that the Redfern Station Upgrade – New Southern Concourse offsets 100 percent of any native vegetation it clears? This means that for any native vegetation we remove, we compensate by planting new vegetation in consultation with City of Sydney Council.

When choosing where to plant vegetation, we consider options where it isn't isolated so people can enjoy it and it provides connectivity to other areas of native vegetation. It is also important that the site be a sustainable option in the long term and the vegetation won't be removed in the future.



## Branching out for community good

Our team recently donated sections of the Eucalyptus trees removed during the recent expansion of the Marian Street site compound to the WILD LIFE Sydney Zoo in Darling Harbour. These sections will be used in their koala and sugar glider enclosures. The team at WILD LIFE Sydney Zoo were grateful for the donation and confident that their furry friends would be especially pleased with their new perches. The Wildlife Sydney Zoo team visited us at our compound in Marian Street to meet with the team before taking the new perches to their new home.

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## What's ahead for the next three months

To minimise disruption to train services and for the safety of the community and workers, weekend work is completed during scheduled trackwork weekends. The table below provides an overview of the weekend work scheduled for the project over the next three months.

This work may be noisy at times and we will implement measures to reduce potential impacts such as turning off equipment when not in use and where possible using noise blankets. We will also notify residents directly where a direct noise impact is expected to occur closer to the time of impact.
