



# Redfern Station Upgrade

## New Southern Concourse

Project newsletter and construction update

March 2021

The Redfern Station Upgrade – New Southern Concourse will make it easier for all customers to access Redfern Station, improve customer experience and movement, relieve congestion at the station and improve connections to key destinations and surrounding areas. This project is the first stage in renewing the Redfern North Eveleigh Precinct.

### Project update

With the site now almost completely established with hoardings installed and the ground prepared for the new Marian Street entrance, construction is now beginning.

Before commencing construction, we were exceedingly grateful to have Brendan from the Metropolitan Local Aboriginal Land Council join us to perform a Welcome to Country and smoking ceremony. The ceremony cleansed and formally introduced the project team to the land. Brendan's words were also a reminder of the importance of the area and its significance to the local Aboriginal community.

### Upcoming work activities

Construction hoardings have been installed on Platforms 4/5, 6/7, 8/9 and 10 which enables work to be carried out behind them during the day. Hoardings for the other platforms will be installed over the next two months. Ongoing work activities during standard hours between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm Saturday** include construction of the support structures and footings for the new footbridge, installation of cable routes, services, overhead wire structures and electrical works.

## Weekend and night work activities

For the safety of staff and customers much of our work needs to be completed outside of standard working hours at times when trains are not running. These are primarily during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekends. The table below includes detailed information about upcoming weekend and night work periods in March, as well as future work weekends.

Residents adjacent to the work will be provided with additional updates if work is assessed to have a direct impact at their location.

The following are scheduled trackwork weekends when we will carry out weekend work at Redfern Station:

- **2am Saturday 12 June to 2am Monday 14 June**
- **2am Saturday 26 June to 2am Monday 27 June**

## What you may notice

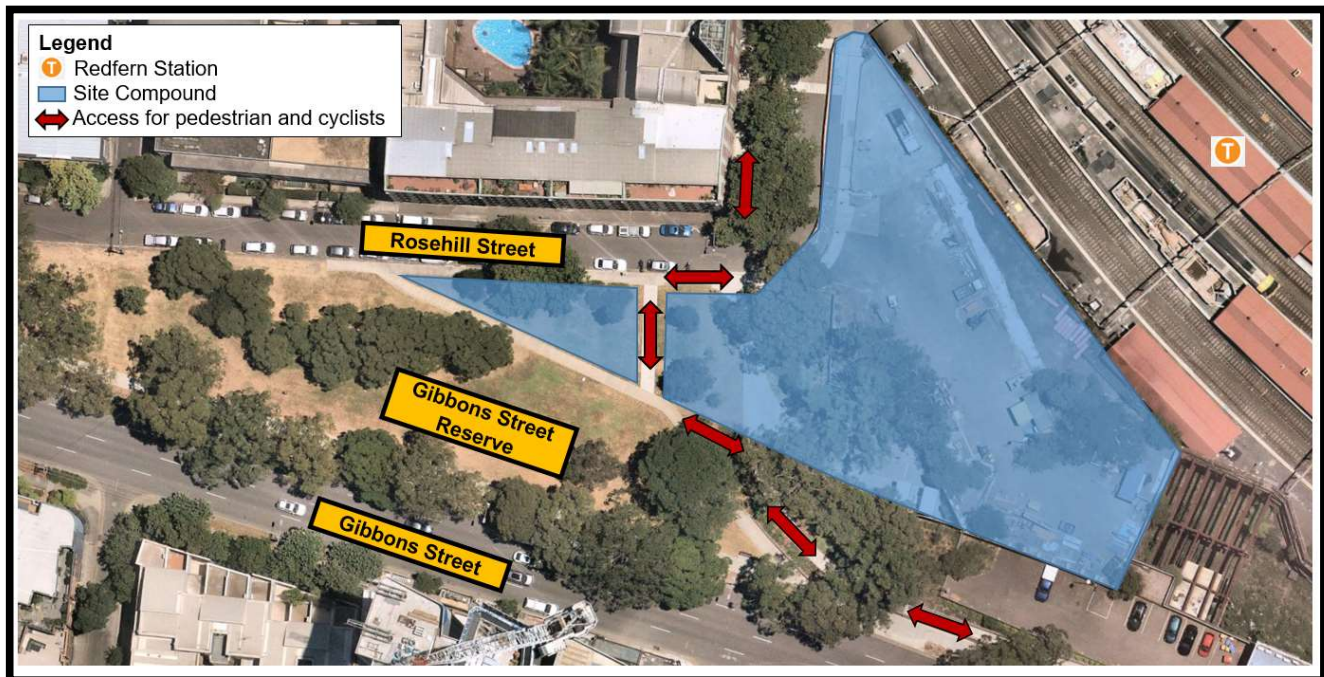
Equipment to be used during these period includes cranes, flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, vacuum trucks, concrete saw, core hole drill, plate compactor, piling rigs, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, compactors, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools.

Where work occurs adjacent to an operational platform, temporary barricades and staff will be in place to direct customers.

In advance of the work listed above, plant and equipment will be delivered into the rail corridor via various rail access gates in Redfern, Eveleigh and Erskineville. Heavy vehicles will use local streets to access the rail corridor. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.

## Site compound establishment – Gibbons Street Reserve

In March, the current site compound at the corner of Rosehill and Marian Streets will be extended into the northern end of Gibbons Street Reserve. This will improve access into the site area providing sufficient space for the delivery of girders and components for the new concourse and provide space for the crane that will periodically arrive at site to deliver materials and plant onto the platforms and install the concourse components. The area will also be used to store materials and components prior to their installation. The extended site area is a reduction of the space originally identified in the Environmental Impact Statement. The majority of Gibbons Street Reserve will remain available for residents and the local community throughout construction and the site compound area will be reinstated at the completion of the project.
