New Southern Concourse

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

January 2021

The Redfern Station Upgrade – New Southern Concourse will make it easier for all customers to access Redfern Station, improve customer experience and movement, relieve congestion at the station and improve connections to key destinations and surrounding areas. This project is the first stage in renewing the Redfern North Eveleigh Precinct.

Project update

The Department of Planning, Industry and Environment approved construction of the new southern concourse at Redfern Station in December 2020 and work has commenced, including the installation of hoardings on Platforms 6/7, 8/9 and 10.

Upcoming work activities

In the first quarter of 2021 work on the new concourse will continue on the platforms during standard construction hours, 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8pm to 6pm Saturday. This will include saw cutting along the platform surfaces, service investigations and relocations, delivery of materials to the hoarded areas and work behind the hoardings including excavation and piling to construct the piers to support the new concourse.

A site compound will also be established within rail land at North Eveleigh, located between Carriageworks and Little Eveleigh Street.

Night work activities

On occasion, materials and equipment will be removed or delivered to the platforms at night between 10pm and 4am during the week. This will not impact train services and is not expected to be noisy or disruptive. Electrical work will also occur at night to upgrade power boards on the station and install cables and conduits for station services. Undertaking these low noise activities at night reduces the impact to station operations during the day.

Weekend work activities

Weekend work during scheduled trackwork weekends will occur around the clock. The table over the page outlines these weekend work activities.

Residents and the community adjacent to the work activities will be notified and consulted close to the dates when the scope of work for each weekend is confirmed.

What you may notice

In advance of the work listed above, plant and equipment will be delivered into the rail corridor via various rail access gates in Redfern and Eveleigh. Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.

Equipment to be used during the work includes cranes, flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, vacuum trucks, concrete saw, core hole drill, piling rigs, concrete truck and pump, compactors, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools. Work may occur adjacent to operational platforms. Temporary barricades will be in place when this occurs.

Construction activities are noisy by nature. Transport for NSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively

For the safety of staff and customers this work needs to be completed during scheduled trackwork weekends when trains are not running. For up-to-date information about services during these times visit transportnsw.info or call **131 500**.
