Project update

July will be our most significant month since Christmas with a number of key activities scheduled across the footprint of the project. We have spent the last seven months working 'below the ground' to establish bridge foundations and footings, and now you will start to see the Redfern Station Upgrade progress 'above the ground.' In particular, you will see the skyline above Redfern Station begin to transform with the installation of the bridge beams across Platforms 1 to 10.

We will continue our work behind the platform hoardings and on the new station entrance within the Marian Street compound. Activities to prepare Little Eveleigh Street for its new station entrance will also begin.

Standard work hours are between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 6pm Saturday**. For up to date information about train and bus services please contact **131 500** or visit transportnsw.info.



Little Eveleigh Street activities

During July, there will be a number of activities in Little Eveleigh Street including a change in route for the current cycle path, locating of underground services, and installation of hoarding in front of 125 – 127 Little Eveleigh Street to enable the delivery of materials in advance of construction of the new station entrance.

From **Wednesday 7 July until mid-2022** the cycle path will detour via Ivy and Lawson Streets.

The cycle detour route is required to ensure the safety of cyclists while the new station entrance is being constructed. To assist with the change, all car parking spaces on the eastern side of Ivy Street will be removed to paint the cycle detour route from **4pm Monday 5 July until 12am Tuesday 6 July**. Cycle graphics will be stencilled on Lawson Street from **4pm Monday 5 July until 6am Tuesday 6 July** and from **4pm Tuesday 6 July until 6am Wednesday 7 July**. The existing cycle path on Little Eveleigh Street will be painted over in black on **Wednesday 7 July**. The traffic lights at the intersection of Lawson and Abercrombie Streets will be adjusted to also reflect the changes.



Underground service searching will commence **from Wednesday 7 July to Monday 19 July**. **Up to three car spaces will be periodically unavailable** during this time as this activity is completed along the street. During the work a vacuum truck will be used to help locate underground services and traffic control will be in place to safely direct vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians.

Work will continue on the construction of the car park at the southern end of Little Eveleigh Street.

Concourse beam deliveries – temporary changes to traffic and parking

During July there will be changes to traffic movements and parking to enable the safe delivery and installation of the beams for the new concourse. These beams are around 31 metres long and weigh 37 tonnes. Due to their size, they are being delivered by large trucks as 'oversize' loads.

The beams will be installed at the following times:

- **7am Saturday 17 to 7pm Sunday 18 July** (lift from Marian Street Compound)
- **7am Saturday 24 to 7pm Sunday 25 July** (lift from North Eveleigh Car Park)
- **11pm Saturday 31 July to 8am 1 August** (lift from Marian Street Compound)

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The deliveries will occur:

- From **10pm to 5am** on the nights of **Thursday 15 and Friday 16 July, and Thursday 29 and Friday 30 July** to the Marian Street Compound via Rosehill and Marian Streets
- From **10am to 5am** on the nights of **Thursday 22 and Friday 23 July** to the North Eveleigh car park via Carriageworks Way

Traffic control, detour and information signage will be place to assist motorists, cyclists and pedestrians around the area. Arborists may also undertake activities, such as trimming, along Rosehill and Marian Streets in order protect the trees in those streets during the bridge beam deliveries and ensure a safe pathway for the vehicles.

Parking changes

Oversized vehicles and plant will be used to ensure the safe delivery of the concourse beams. To enable these deliveries, parking will be temporarily removed on the following dates and locations:

Road closures

To enable the delivery, set up and installation of the new concourse beams, **a temporary road closure will occur on Rosehill and Marian Streets between Margaret and Cornwallis Streets** during the following dates and times. **Residential and emergency services access will be maintained during this period.**

- From **12am Friday 16 July to 2am Monday 19 July**
- From **12am Friday 30 July to 2am Monday 2 August**

Weekend and night work activities

The table on the next page includes detailed information about upcoming weekend and night work periods in July.

Equipment to be used during these times may include cranes, cherry pickers, flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, forklifts, vacuum trucks, concrete saw, core hole drill, plate compactor, piling rigs, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, jackhammer, compactors, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools.

Please note in our June quarterly newsletter, we advised that work for the project would occur every weekend in July. We have since been able to adjust our program and weekend works outside of standard working hours have been reduced. A revised program is shown in the table on the next page.
