

Redfern Station Upgrade

New Southern Concourse

Project update

Throughout September, preparation work for construction will continue for the upgrade of Redfern Station, this will consist of:

- the installation of the last bridge beams across Platforms 1 to 4,
- preparatory work of the shared zone on Little Eveleigh Street,
- commencement of work on the bridge including construction of lift shafts and stairs that will form part of the New Southern Concourse.

During this work we will be continuing to implement COVID safe practices in line with NSW Health's COVID-19 public health orders and restrictions.

Little Eveleigh Street update

Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 restrictions, the finalisation of the car park and the beginning of main construction of the shared zone has been delayed. Residents who are directly impacted will receive updated information once details are confirmed.

Preparation for construction work will continue for the new shared zone. Preparation activities will occur in the thoroughfare between Wilson Street and Ivy Lane and will include the temporary removal of bollards, adjustments and asphaltting on the curbing, removal of a garden bed and trimming of trees.

In late September we will be recommencing construction on the car park. Minimal vegetation clearance and tree trimming will occur to enable construction of the new accessway into the car park.

Exploration of underground services and potholing will continue on Little Eveleigh Street and Ivy Street from **Wednesday 1 September to Thursday 30 September. Up to six car spaces will be periodically unavailable** during this time as work continues along both streets. While these activities are not required every day, they are dependant on weather conditions and availability of parking. Signage and traffic control will be in place to safely direct vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians during this work.

Activities will continue inside 125-127 Little Eveleigh Street and deliveries of equipment and materials within the hoarded area. As previously notified, two trees outside of the building will be removed to facilitate the new Redfern Station entrance.

Platforms and Marian Street update

Final preparation work and relocation of the heritage building will start to take place on and behind Platform 1. A vacuum truck will be used throughout September to finalise the preparation for the movement of the building. Work continues inside the platform hoardings on support structures, lift shafts and stairs.

An arborist will undertake required tree trimming along Rosehill and Marian Streets during September to ensure a safe pathway for plant and equipment. Traffic control will be present to temporarily stop traffic when the tree branches are being trimmed.

Minor traffic delays may be experienced to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and cyclists. Excavation, piling and the installation of underground service routes will continue in the Marian Street Compound.

Bridge beam delivery and parking changes

The remaining bridge beams will be delivered from **10am to 5am on the nights of Thursday 9 September and Friday 10 September to the North Eveleigh car park via Carriageworks Way.**

Oversized vehicles and plant equipment will be used to ensure the safe delivery of the concourse beams. To enable these deliveries, six parking spaces will be temporarily removed from **4pm Thursday 9 September to 8pm Saturday 11 September** on the corner of Wilson Street and Carriageworks Way.

Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm Saturday.
