

Power Supply Upgrade AC Feeder Upgrade Project – Revesby and Bankstown

Community Notification

November 2021

Project overview

The AC Feeder Upgrade Project is part of the Power Supply Upgrade which is designed to meet expected power requirements for Sydney's future rail network and new fleet of air-conditioned trains. The work involves upgrades to substations, section huts, overhead wiring and feeders as well as the construction of new infrastructure across the network.

Upcoming work

The AC Feeder Upgrade Project team will be carrying out work to upgrade and replace power poles at various locations along Albert Street, Revesby and Mons Street and Northam Avenue, Bankstown between 7am and 6pm Wednesday 15 November to Tuesday 21 December 2021, on weekdays only. The work includes:

- Delivering plant and materials to each site in turn, setting up safety barriers, reserving parking spaces
- Using an auger to pre-bore holes for new poles, backfilling and ensuring the location is safe for the public
- Installing new power poles on a different day to the augering
- Undertaking traffic management around the location of the pole replacement works. Closure of one lane
 will be needed in most situations. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place. Access to properties
 will remain, with minor delays and assistance of the traffic controllers on occasion. Deliveries of poles
 by semitrailer will impact traffic for 5 to 15 minutes typically.
- Properties in close proximity to a new pole will receive additional and specific information closer to the time.

Equipment to be used for this work includes an excavator with auger or truck-mounted auger, skip bins, semitrailer delivering poles, mobile crane, other construction vehicles and handheld power tools.

The locations of work are shown on the maps on the next page, and will be Albert Street, Revesby; Mons Street, Bankstown; and Northam Avenue, Bankstown.

What you may notice

Transport for NSW is committed to minimising impact on the community. We switch off equipment when it is not being used and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively. From 27 November 2021 Ausgrid will schedule up to 8-hour power outages affecting a small number of properties to allow for the safe installation of poles each week. Ausgrid will distribute separate notifications about these outages. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience this work may cause.
