

# Commuter Car Park Program Riverwood

## More commuter car parking is coming to Riverwood Station

Planning is underway to deliver additional commuter car parking spaces at Riverwood Station to provide you with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments.

Key features of the proposal include:

- a ground plus two level multi-storey car park on Webb Street, providing up to 140 additional commuter parking spaces
- accessible parking spaces
- lift access
- installation of CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage for safety and security
- provision for electric vehicle charging spaces
- rooftop solar panels
- Transport Park&Ride infrastructure (Opal operated boom gates)
- landscaping around the multi-storey car park.

Subject to planning approval, construction is planned to begin at the end of 2021 and is expected to be completed by the end of 2022.

Transport for NSW is working directly with affected landowners and tenants to ensure they have information about the proposal, as well as the support and resources needed during the property acquisition process.

A new multi-storey car park at this location will provide safe, accessible and convenient commuter parking close to the station, and help meet the growing demand for commuter car parking in the area.

### Provide your feedback

An environmental impact assessment in the form of a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) has been prepared to support the project. The REF outlines a number of factors relating to the proposal including traffic, noise, visual and community impacts during both construction and operation. The REF also identifies potential mitigation measures that would be implemented to ensure these impacts are appropriately managed during both construction and operation to minimise impacts to the local residents.
