### Accessibility upgrade now complete

Thank you for your patience and cooperation throughout the construction of the Roseville Station Upgrade. The upgraded facilities are now available to customers including:

- ✓ new screens and handrails on the existing footbridge
- ✓ two lifts to provide access between Hill Street, the existing footbridge and the station platform (open on 8 November)
- ✓ accessible pathways to the station to provide access between the Pacific Highway and the existing footbridge
- ✓ canopies at the Hill Street station entrance and the platform boarding assistance zone

- ✓ an interchange zone including accessible parking, taxi zone, kiss and ride bay, bus shelter and increased bike parking on Hill Street and Pacific Highway

- ✓ improved CCTV and lighting
- ✓ new landscaping and gardens at the Pacific Highway and Hill Street entrances.

## Finishing work

Customers may continue to see construction staff on site throughout November while minor finishing work is completed.

From **6am to 7pm on Saturday 6 November and Sunday 7 November** paint touch ups, general polishing and cleaning will be carried out over the weekend.

The storage and laydown areas in the commuter car park on Hill Street will also be demobilised and tidied, ahead of being handed back to the community later this month.
