Upcoming construction work

The following work will occur in October:

- formwork and concrete work will continue on the extension levels
- fit out and painting work will start on the lower levels
- piling work will begin around the perimeter of the car park

Please note that in order to undertake the extension work safely, the lift will not be in operation until the end of the year. Subject to approval, to enable the lift work, up to eight motorcycle parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable until early 2022. Parking is currently available on the ground and Level 1 of the car park.

Transport for NSW is providing additional commuter parking at St Marys, a joint initiative of the Australian and NSW Governments. This will provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads.

This project will add two levels to the existing multi-storey commuter car park to provide around 250 new spaces, and support the new Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project. The new metro railway line will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. The city-shaping project will deliver new stations at St Marys, Orchard Hills, Luddenham, Airport Business Park, Airport Terminal and the Western Sydney Aerotropolis. The 23 kilometre new railway is planned to open at the same time as passenger services start at the airport.

Updated construction hours

Work will generally take place during standard construction hours between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.**

In line with the NSW Government's rules for extended work hours, we may undertake work from 1pm to 5pm on Saturday and from 9am to 5pm on Sundays.

Deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak times wherever possible to minimise disruption to local businesses, pedestrians and motorists.

Vegetation removal

Some trees and vegetation will need to be removed for the car park extension. All trees removed as part of the project will be offset with landscaping at the end of the project.
