Veness Place Car Park Closure

St Marys Station Project Update | August 2021

Transport for NSW is delivering improvements across the state to create vibrant, productive, liveable and sustainable places that support community health, safety and wellbeing. To promote future employment growth, support the local population now and into the future, and to improve connections across Greater Western Sydney, St Marys Station and precinct is being renewed.


Sydney Metro - Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. The city-shaping project will deliver new stations at the Western Sydney Aerotropolis, Western Sydney International, Luddenham, Orchard Hills and St Marys - where passengers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains T1 Western Line. The 23 kilometre new railway is planned to open at the same time as passenger services start at the airport.

Construction of a new temporary bus interchange

In September 2021 Transport for NSW will start construction of a new, temporary bus interchange for St Marys town centre. The existing bus interchange area will be used for the construction of the St Marys metro station. To continue operations, the bus interchange on Station Street will be relocated across the road to the Veness Place car park and there will be changes to road zoning and existing car parking.

Indicative timeline

The timeline below outlines progress to date and upcoming changes.



Progress to date

In July, Transport for NSW doorknocked business owners and tenants in Station, Queen and Phillip Streets to provide an update on the planned work and understand their needs and concerns. The feedback we received focussed on garbage collection, supplier deliveries, and on-site tenant parking accessed via East Lane.

During construction of the temporary bus interchange, East Lane will remain open for vehicle access from Phillip Street and pedestrian access between Station Street and Phillip Street. Garbage collection, deliveries and on-site parking will not be impacted. Occasionally, we may need to limit East Lane access to allow for minor construction works such as road resurfacing or repairs but we will provide advance notice of any disruption.



Other parking nearby

We understand changes to parking may be difficult and you will need to use other parking options. Beacroft Place car park located 250 metres south on East Lane between Gidley Street has 340 spaces available with a 3 hour parking time limit.

We recommend commuters use available commuter parking or consider nearby stations including Werrington, Kingswood, Mt Druitt and Rooty Hill. Additional parking is also available in the Penrith Station multi storey car park with express train services into the Sydney CBD.

Next Steps

In September we will update you with more detailed information about construction including key dates and the expected scope of work. These works are in line with the current Public Health Orders. Please note the evolving situation with COVID may impact our planned dates of work and require some scheduling flexibility.
