St Peters Station Upgrade

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

The St Peters Station Upgrade is part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Mid-week work between 5 July and 30 July

Following planning approval to deliver an accessible station, early works and site establishment will be undertaken **from 5 July to 30 July (weekdays only) between 7am and 6pm**. This includes:

- disconnecting services within the concourse kiosk and preparing the kiosk area for construction
- excavation and preparation for construction of lifts on all platforms
- installation of timber hoarding around excavation areas
- site establishment at Concord Street between Bray and King Streets, including tree trimming and deliveries of site office buildings – subject to approval.

What to expect

- Plant and machinery will access the rail corridor via the rail access gate on Concord Street between King and Bray Streets.
- Traffic and pedestrian control will be in place while deliveries are made to Concord Street.
- Equipment to be used throughout the month includes crane truck, excavators, hi-rail trucks, telehandler, elevated work platform, concrete pumps, hi-rail crane, forklift, chainsaw and chipper and various hand and power tools.

What you may notice

Some of this work may be noisy at times however, we will make every effort to minimise the impact to nearby residents and businesses.

Wherever possible, measures to reduce noise will be implemented including turning equipment off when not in use, positioning equipment as far away from residences as possible, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and stopping work for respite periods.

We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience while we carry out these works.
