Stanmore Station Upgrade

Project update

August 2021

Transport for NSW is investigating options for the proposed upgrade of Stanmore Station to make it easier to access, especially for people with disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work in August and September

From **Monday 30 August up to Saturday 18 September** geotechnical investigations will take place over 12 shifts. These investigations are critical to inform the design for the proposed Stanmore Station upgrade and to complete work started in August. Bore hole drilling will take place on platforms 1/2 and 3. Equipment to be used will be vacuum truck, drilling rig and non-powered hand tools.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians and motorists around the area when required. The work activities may be noisy at times. We apologise for the inconvenience and will minimise the impact by turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use, monitoring noise levels and using non-tonal reversing beepers and acoustic barriers.

Road closures

- **One lane on Trafalgar St** will be closed during work periods, for a maximum of three shifts. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist motorists. Please drive carefully through the area.
- There are no pedestrian access changes to the station entrance and underpass.
- Access will be maintained for emergency vehicles at all times.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are **7am to 5pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.
