

# Redfern Station Upgrade

## New Southern Concourse

### Project update

Throughout December, construction activities will include:

- construction preparation works for the new shared zone and station entrance on Little Eveleigh Street, including the North Eveleigh car park, with a scheduled start of street construction in early 2022
- work at the Marian Street and North Eveleigh compound area and on the bridge, including construction of the bridge canopy, lift shafts and stairs

We have measures in place to mitigate any noise or vibration impacts. All activities being undertaken adhere to COVID safe practices and will continue to be in line with NSW Health’s COVID-19 Public Health Orders and restrictions.

Installation of service routes, drainage, various bridge steel components, lift shafts and stairs, changes to overhead wiring and overhead wiring structures, and delivery of plant, equipment and materials.  <b>Pedestrian access to Platform 10 will be closed Saturday 18 December and Sunday 19 December, and Sunday 26 December to Friday 31 December.</b> Traffic control and pedestrian detour signs will be in place to direct customers via Gibbons Street.  *Program subject to change due to COVID-19 impacts. <b>6pm – 6am nights during the month of December</b>	Various platforms and the access gates at Newtown, Eveleigh, and Erskineville.  North Eveleigh and Marian Street site compounds.	Installation of the bridge canopy and associated temporary works will be undertaken <b>from 1 December to 31 December for up to two nights per week.</b>  Two additional nights per week may be required for other activities such as material and equipment removal, deliveries, concrete pouring, and electrical work may occur. However, the work activities for these additional nights are not expected to be noisy.

## Little Eveleigh Street update

Final preparation work for the new shared zone includes the temporary removal of bollards, work on curbs and removal of a garden bed between Wilson Street and Ivy Lane.

Construction of the car park will continue throughout December, as will minor works in the building at 125-127 Little Eveleigh Street.

## Station area and platforms update

Work being carried out on and behind Platform 1 includes rock breaking, excavation work, piling, concreting, drilling and material removal. A vacuum truck will be used throughout the month, and a crane will be periodically used to lift various materials into place.

Work will continue inside the platform hoardings on support structures and on the bridge for construction of the lift shafts, stairs and bridge canopy.

## Marian Street update

An arborist will be undertaking required tree trimming along Rosehill and Marian Streets where required to maintain a safe pathway for plant and equipment to travel to the Marian Street site compound. Traffic control will be present to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and cyclists during this activity.

Work on the assembly of lift shafts, bridge canopy, other bridge components and the electrical building will continue in the Marian Street Compound. This compound will also be periodically used by a crane to lift various materials into place.

## Christmas Shutdown update

Work on the bridge will continue between **2am Sunday 26 December and 12pm Friday 31 December**, while trains are not running. Work being carried out during this time includes lifting in bridge sections, lift shafts and stairs that form part of the New Southern Concourse.

Quieter work activities such as packing up the site area will occur on 31 December. We will provide the community with more information closer to the date.

## Upcoming deliveries and parking removal

During December there will be changes to traffic movements and parking on Marian, Rosehill and Wilson Streets. This is to enable material and equipment to be safely delivered to the project's site compounds.

**Up to 20 parking spaces on Rosehill Street and 2 parking spaces on Marian Street will be temporarily removed** during the dates below.

- From Thursday 2 to Saturday 4 December
- From Monday 13 to Friday 17 December

**Up to 6 parking spaces on Rosehill Street and 2 parking spaces on Marian Street will be temporarily removed** during the dates below.

- From Sunday 5 to Monday 6 December
- From Sunday 12 to Monday 13 December

**Up to 6 parking spaces on Wilson Street will be temporarily removed** during the dates below.

- From Tuesday 7 to Sunday 12 December
- From Tuesday 14 to Thursday 16 December
- From Sunday 19 to Tuesday 21 December

*Please refer to the maps on the following pages for reference of these temporary parking changes.*

**From Tuesday 21 December to Friday 31 December parking spaces will be temporarily removed along Marian Street and along both sides of Rosehill Street** to prepare for, and undertake work during the Christmas Shutdown period.

During this time, there will be also be a temporary road closure on Rosehill and Marian Streets between Margaret and Cornwallis Streets. Residential and emergency services access will be maintained and traffic control will be in place to manage cyclists, pedestrians and motorists. These dates are subject to change, but we will provide an update closer to the date.

**Standard construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm Saturday.** Due to unforeseen weather events some construction activities may run slightly past 6pm, but these activities are not expected to be noisy.

## What you may notice

Equipment to be used during these activities may include cranes, elevated work platforms, access equipment, flatbed crane trucks, excavators, dump trucks, core hole drills, compactors, concrete trucks and concrete pumps, lighting towers, generators, work vehicles, hand and power tools.

At times, our activities require the use of equipment that operates at a higher sound level than standard equipment. This includes power saws, grinders, jackhammers, rollers, rattle guns, vacuum trucks, rock hammers or breakers and piling rigs.

The use of some equipment can also cause vibration, and may be noticeable to nearby residents. We will minimise noise and vibration impacts by turning off equipment when not in use, and using noise absorbing blankets where possible. A real-time environmental management system is also in place to ensure noise, vibration, and dust levels are operating within our project requirements.
