The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Towradgi Station.

This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.



Upcoming work

Construction of the Towradgi Station upgrade is currently under way. Work will continue throughout July and includes:

- Excavation works behind Platforms 1 & 2 for future lift and stair construction
- Start of concrete pouring for footbridge structure on Platforms 1 & 2
- Hoarding installation on platforms.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, hammer drills, bobcats, concrete trucks and pumps, hand held saws, large cranes and power tools.

Temporary changes to station platform




Following weekend work starting 26 June, hoarding will be installed on the platform, as per the graphic.

This work will create safe exclusion zones for upcoming excavation of Platforms 1 and 2 that will slightly reduce the platform width.

Customers are urged to continue moving along these areas for safety and clearance purposes.

There will be signage on display and announcements over the station's public address system to remind commuters of this change.



Construction hours

To support industry and continue the delivery of critical infrastructure, the NSW Government has introduced new rules allowing construction sites to operate on weekends and public holidays. Standard construction hours are now **7am to 6pm every day**, **including Sundays and public holidays**. These changes have been made to facilitate social distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers.
