The Thornleigh Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

September work

Our September work will continue with excavation and piling work for the new lifts and our work hours remain unchanged, between **Monday and Friday 7am and 6pm**.

October work

Our October work may require up to four nights' of work from **2am Saturday 2 October to 6pm Wednesday 6 October**. During this month we will be working to carry out the following activities:

- Installation of hoarding on the platform around the work zones
- Installation of working platform for works
- Excavation and piling work
- Formation of the new lifts
- Installation of cables within the rail corridor.

Benowie Walkway closure

We recently notified you of the temporary closure of the Benowie Walkway for the month of August while work is carried out.

Due to the decreased volumes of passengers near Thornleigh Station, during the COVID-19 stay at home orders, we have identified a further opportunity to continue the temporary closure of Benowie Walkway.

This will allow us to complete our work faster, safer and more efficiently during this quiter period at the station, and extend this full closure until April 2022.

All pedestrians are directed to use The Esplande, Wells Street and Pennant Hills Road for access. Please refer to traffic control and signage on site for directions.

How will this work effect you?

Equipment that will be used throughout September and October will include; excavators, piling machinery, vaccum trucks, road saws, tipper trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, dump trucks, chainsaws, chippers, lighting towers, various power tools.

Where possible, measures will be implemented to reduce noise and dust associated with this work, including adding shade cloth mesh to fencing, using noise blankets, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Temporary removal of parking spaces

Two car parking spaces adjacent to the station entrance on Railway Parade, next to the cafe will be unavailable up until April 2022, to allow for machinery to access the work zone safely.

An additional five, 1 hour timed, parking spaces further along Railway Parade will be used for a work zone and unavailable for public use up until April 2022.
