The Thornleigh Station Upgrade is part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Project update

Excavation and piling for the new lifts at Thornleigh Station is complete, as well as the demolition of the Railway Parade stairs to make way for the new lift.

We understand that this year has been challenging for all, so the Thornleigh Station Upgrade project team would like the opportunity to thank the community for their understanding and support to the Thornleigh Station Upgrade team.

Our work will **conclude for this year on Tuesday 21 December** and **resume on Monday 10 January 2022**.



How will this work effect you?

Equipment used throughout December includes; excavators, vaccum trucks, road saws, jackhammers, tipper trucks, concrete trucks and pumps, dump trucks, various power tools.

December work

Throughout December, work will include:

- Continue construction of the new lifts, including concreting works
- Upgrades to the station platform waiting rooms
- Construction of a new family toilet and an accessible toilet

Did you know?

Have you noticed the yellow boxes located on the station platforms? These boxes are called protection boxes and are in place to protect you from some of the bolts we have installed in the ground. These boxes have a pointy top to stop pigeons roosting or passengers leaving their coffee cups on top!
