Transport for NSW is upgrading Wahroonga Station to provide a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

The upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.

Major construction commenced in January 2021 following site establishment and early work conducted last year.

Upcoming work

Work will continue in February and includes:

- service and utility investigations
- · relocation of electrical and communication services
- vegetation clearing and trimming
- installation of temporary structures.

Equipment to be used includes surveying equipment, vacuum trucks, concrete pumps, tipper trucks, small excavators, light vehicles and hand tools.

Construction hours

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**, **and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
