Upcoming work

Construction activities in October include:

- resurfacing and drainage work to the Narara Valley Drive Carpark station entrance
- electrical and communication works
- landscaping work around the station
- construction of the new pedestrian ramp from Narara Valley Drive to the station entrance, including earthworks and concrete work
- regrading, concrete work and asphaltting of the Narara Valley Drive station entrance
- installation of hearing loops on the station platforms
- modifications to Platform 1 waiting area to provide accessibility
- relocation and installation of underground and above ground services
- upgrades to footbridge including handrails, screens, stair nosings and installation of tactiles.

Equipment to be used includes surveying equipment, vacuum trucks, elevated working platforms, excavators, cranes, semi-trailers, concrete pumps, piling rig, scaffolding, light vehicles and hand tools.

Temporary access changes and bus stop relocation

Numerous access changes continue to be in place on Narara Valley Drive and Goonak Parade until **late October 2021**. Signage and barriers will be in place to assist road users and pedestrians during this time. Additional changes in October include:

- The permanent entrance to Platform 1 from Goonak Parade has now been open to the public.

Construction hours

Construction for the Narara Station upgrade is now in its final stages. The majority of construction work is expected to be complete in late October.

Standard construction hours are now between **7am to 6pm every day**. This is to facilitate social distancing on construction sites and support the health and wellbeing of workers. For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

Our crews will comply with all NSW Health COVID regulations while they carry out these works, with traffic control on site for driver and pedestrian safety.
