Project update

Transport for NSW is delivering additional commuter car parking at West Ryde Station to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads.

When complete, the new car park will be located along Ryedale Road and will provide the community with approximately 100 additional commuter parking spaces. The car park is expected to be completed and open to the community by the end of 2021.

Progress update

Over April and May, the commuter car park closest to the station was closed and site establishment was completed. The existing trees and structures inside the site were removed. Trees removed for the new commuter car park will be offset at the end of the project.

Detailed design

Detailed design for the new commuter car park is progressing. We will share the updated design with the community shortly.

Upcoming construction work

During June and July, the following work will occur on the new car park:

- Earthworks and associated bulk-out of redundant material will be undertaken
- Detailed excavation to allow for in-ground services such as storm water
- Commencement of the new car park subgrade preparations
- Installation of new in ground services
- Removal of old rail corridor fence and installation of new rail corridor fence

Construction hours

Work will take place during standard construction hours between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.** Deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak times wherever possible to minimise disruption to pedestrians and motorists.

Council Works along Ryedale Road

City of Ryde Council are undertaking work along Ryedale Road as part of the Ryedale Road Town Centre Upgrade project and have engaged Ferrycarrig to deliver the project on their behalf. Upcoming work will include demolition and construction of new kerb and gutters, new light poles and installation of new underground electrical and storm water service lines. Some of this work is scheduled to take place at night starting at 4:30pm for the next few weeks.
