# **Project Update**

The team at Wollstonecraft completed a significant amount of scope during the March 2021 work weekend, despite there being torrential rain throughout the course of the weekend.

The following was achieved:

- · drainage work in the station underpass
- demolition and concreting of the Platform 1 waiting room
- delivery of structural steel for the western entry ramp, lift 2 and Platform 2 canopy
- start of installation of the western entry ramp
- delivery and installation of an electrical cabinet near the entry to Platform 1 off Shirley Road
- installing a service pole on Shirley Road.

## **Upcoming work**

Work will continue in April and includes:

- electrical upgrades on Platform 1
- delivering materials and removing spoil
- constructing a new station waiting room on Platform 1
- bridge and lift landing work on the eastern entrance to Platform 1
- excavating trenches for new electrical services along the walkways and platform, and in the grass area near the entry to Platform 2
- temporary closure of the northern entrance to Platform 1 and partial closure of the underpass for drainage work
- toilet refurbishment (one unisex toilet on Platform 1 will remain open)
- erecting structural steel and reinforcement on Platform 2 near the western walkway
- installing lift shaft and boarding assistance zone canopy on Platform 2.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, trucks, demolition saws, grinders, hydraulic hammers, cranes, rattle guns, plumbing tools, scaffolding, demolition tools, pallet jacks, dump trucks and hand tools.

# Night work in April

For the safety of our workers and commuters, we will be undertaking up to two shifts of work at night, between 1am and 4am on Tuesday 20 April and Wednesday 21 April, weather permitting.

This night work will involve relocating equipment and machinery from the project's construction site compound to Shirley Road via the railway line.

Equipment to be used includes elevated work platform and hand tools.

This work is not expected to be noisy. Wherever possible measures to reduce noise will be implemented including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

# Temporary pedestrian access changes during April

From **7am Thursday 1 April to 5pm Friday 30 April**, the entrance to Platform 1 from Shirley Road will be temporarily closed. This closure will enable the installation of stormwater drainage along the footpath and the safe installation of the lift on Platform 1.

To access Platform 1, customers and pedestrians will be required to detour via the Platform 2 entry through the underpass, or via Shirley Lane. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist pedestrians while these changes are in place. **Access to the shop on Platform 1 will be maintained at all times.**

## Temporary changes to the station toilets

Work is in progress to refurbish the existing toilets at Wollstonecraft Station to provide one family accessible toilet and two ambulant toilets.

While work is carried out to enable the refurbishments, one toilet will be closed and one toilet will be converted to a unisex toilet for all customers to use. Signage is in place to direct customers to the unisex toilet.

## **Construction hours**

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays.** For the safety of staff, customers and the community, some work will be completed outside standard construction hours. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.
