St Peters Station Upgrade

The St Peters Station Upgrade is part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a station that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams, and customers with luggage.

Out of hours work to the end of the year

We will be working dayshifts between 7am and 6pm on Sunday 26 December, Monday 27 December and Tuesday 28 December on the platforms at St Peters Station.

The station footbridge will be closed to pedestrians during these work times and open after 6pm.

Work will include:

- Installing an electrical conduit on the underside of the footbridge using elevated work platforms and scaffold
- Using a handheld drill during installation.

We will be delivering work material into the rail corridor from Concord Street. This work will be carried out during a temporary Sydney Trains trackwork possession. For up-to-date information about bus replacement services during this time visit **transportnsw.info** or call **131 500**.

What you may notice

Some of this work may be noisy at times, however we will make every effort to minimise the impact to nearby residents and businesses. Wherever possible, measures to reduce noise will be implemented, including turning equipment off when not in use, positioning equipment as far away from residences as possible, monitoring noise, using non-tonal reversing beepers and stopping work for respite periods. We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience while we carry out these important works.

Other work between St Peters Station and Coulson Street

During this trackwork possession, **Sydney Trains** are undertaking re-railing work on the tracks closest to the Lord Street side of the station towards Coulson Street. Sydney Trains will use the **Council Street** and **Lord Street** access gates for access to site. See map overleaf for indicative location.

What to expect

The St Peters Station project team is committed to following the advice of the NSW Government in accordance with COVID-19 safe practices with the following activities:

- Deliveries of work material and machinery to Concord Street
- Traffic control will be in place to direct traffic and pedestrians when needed
- Equipment used includes; elevated work platform and various hand and power tools.

Access between Lord Street and Goodsell Street will be via Princes Highway at times when the station footbridge is closed.
