What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Central and Strathfield from Friday 23 July to Monday 26 July.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro is:

- Working within the hoardings on Platforms 16-23, the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse and the upper and lower Northern Concourse
- Installing services throughout the station
- Constructing concrete slabs for the metro platforms (underground former Platforms 13, 14-15)

Sydney Trains is working on:

- Civil track maintenance
- Routine signal and electrical maintenance
- Station upgrade works at Redfern
- Sydney Yard overhead wiring rebuild stage works
- Turnout renewal at Redfern
- Turnout resurfacing
- Litter and graffiti removal
- Vegetation maintenance.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- Work will take place around the clock from 11pm Friday 23 July until 2am Monday 26 July.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.
