Hornsby Fencing upgrade

From Monday 8 March to Friday 26 March

What we're doing

We will be renewing a section of the existing rail corridor boundary fence at Hornsby (between George Street and Bridge Road).

This work will necessitate clearing of some vegetation along the fence line.

Sydney Trains has a duty to protect the rail network from vandalism and spends millions of dollars each year on graffiti removal.

Upgraded fencing will improve security for both the railway and property owners bordering the rail corridor.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the day.
- **Weekday work will take place between 6am and 5pm from Monday 8 March to Friday 26 March.**
- **Weekend work will take place on some Saturdays between 7am and 1pm from Saturday 13 March to Saturday 20 March.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to day time travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and parking

- Work vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor wherever possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
