Transport Access Program | June / July 2022

Stanmore Station Upgrade



The Transport Access Program will deliver a better experience for Stanmore Station customers. The upgraded station will be accessible to all, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents and carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Upcoming work

From late June site investigations will take place and the site compound will be set up. Construction work will then start in July.

From Thursday 30 June to Sunday 31 July 2022 our work activities will include:

- site establishment late June
- delivering and installing the site offices and compound facilities within the rail corridor late June to early July
- surveying of land mid-July
- inspecting, investigating and relocating services early to mid-July
- delivering and removing materials, equipment and machinery mid to late July
- delivering and installing site fencing and access gates late July
- hoarding along the centre of the subway late July
- temporary partial road lane closures on Trafalgar Street to enable large tree removal on Platform 3 late July
- pedestrian diversions in the subway and on Douglas Street for hoarding installation late July
- electrical relocation works on Platform 3 late July.

Our work schedule

Standard work hours are between **7am** and **6pm Monday** to **Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

For the safety of commuters, the community and our workers some work will be conducted outside standard construction hours.

We will advise the community of any work required outside these hours and will keep you informed throughout the construction period. Please see the back page for upcoming weekend and night work.

Weekend work / night work

Weekend work that can only be done during scheduled rail shutdown periods took place in late June and will take place in late July. Work took place from **5am Saturday 25 June** to **6pm Sunday 26 June 2022** and those impacted were notified directly. This work included:

- delivering and removing materials, equipment and machinery
- surveying underground services and work areas
- inspecting, investigating and relocating services
- fencing installation and graffiti removal
- temporary partial road lane closure on Trafalgar Street to enable services investigations on Platform 3.

The July weekend work will occur from 2am Saturday 30 July to 10pm Sunday 31 July 2022. This work will include:

- removal of a large tree on Platform 3, at the new lift location
- temporary partial road lane closure on Trafalgar Street to allow for the removal of the large tree
- removal of vegetation and small trees on Platform 3
- start of lift shaft excavation works
- installation of hoarding in the subway and on Platforms 1 and 2.

The equipment used will include vacuum trucks, delivery trucks, elevated work platforms, wood chippers, chainsaws, hand tools, piling rig, excavators, augers, concrete trucks and concrete pumps.

How will the work affect you?

We understand the work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to lessen disturbance, including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

To allow for the delivery and removal of materials, equipment and machinery some of this work will involve temporary partial road lane closures. At these times, signage and traffic control will be in place. For your safety, please follow the direction of traffic control.

Any loss of trees and vegetation on the project will be carried out by a qualified arborist and will be offset with other vegetation and trees.
