The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Towradgi Station. This upgrade will be delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

Work completed in March

During March, both lift shafts had scaffolding removed to reveal the custom-designed concrete panels. We also finished preparation of the station forecourt, which is now ready to be paved.

Upcoming work

In April, we are planning to complete the following:

- · continuing installation of mechanical and electrical services for the new lifts
- · laying foundations for the new footpath on Platform 1
- backfilling the areas behind the new retaining walls on Platform 1 and Platform 2 with a mixture of soil and rocks
- · installing handrails on stairs

Equipment to be used includes delivery and dump trucks, excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, compactor and hand tools.

Vegetation removal

We removed three trees from the embankment next to platform 1 to enable embankment and drainage upgrade works. This planned upgrade work would have damaged the root systems and created a significant safety hazard to the rail corridor by causing instability in the trees.

The removal of these trees will be offset with the planting of 10 trees on site in accordance with the Transport for NSW Vegetation Offset Calculator.

Working hours

The Towradgi Station Upgrade will be operating within standard construction hours, from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Project delays

The ongoing industrial action within Sydney Trains has caused delays to the Towradgi Station Upgrade. It is likely that the construction program will continue until later than expected. We will update you with expected completion dates once the industrial action is over.
