

# Transport Access Program Bellambi Station Upgrade

Community notification December 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Bellambi Station. This upgrade is being delivered as part of the Transport Access Program, an initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering modern, safe and accessible infrastructure.

## Completed work

Resurfacing and concrete work for the new kiss and ride zone on Francis Street was completed in November.

Installation of communications and electrical services continued on the platform and will be completed once the existing station building is demolished in 2023.

The steel structure for the new station building has been fabricated ready for installation.

## Upcoming work

The next stage of the car park upgrade will start this month, including pouring the rest of the concrete footpaths and installing bollards and lighting in the new kiss and ride area.

Final line-marking for the new designated accessible parking spots will also be completed.

In December and January electrical and power supply containment will start along the rail corridor fence next to the car park.

## Commuter car park

Pedestrian access to the car park will change throughout December to allow for the final footpath areas to be finished and operational. Signage will be in place directing customers to the station entrance.

## Working hours

Work will occur during standard hours between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

*All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.*
