Central to Sefton track maintenance

From Saturday 13 August to Monday 15 August

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance between Central and Sefton via Bankstown from Saturday 13 August to Monday 15 August.

At Central Station Sydney Metro is:

- Working within the hoardings on Platforms 16-23, the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse and the upper and lower Northern Concourse
- Installing services throughout the station
- Installing services, lifts, escalators and finishes for the metro platforms (underground former Platforms 13-15 area)
- Reinstating Platforms 13 and 14, including canopies (former Platforms 13-15 area).

Between Sydenham and Bankstown, Sydney Metro work will include:

- Construction of metro services buildings at all sites along the alignment including lifting precast walls, installing structural steel, roofing, installing services and fit-out
- Installing drainage and building footpaths at multiple stations and within the rail corridor
- Upgrades to the concourse precincts including installing canopies and platform furniture
- Installing anti-throw screens and undertaking bridge remediation
- Installing new trackside cabling and equipment
- High voltage electrical work and substation work
- Landscaping work at multiple sites along the alignment.

Sydney Trains is working on:

- Bridge refurbishment at Liverpool Road Overbridge, Yagoona
- Track and turnout resurfacing
- Platform refurbishment at Yagoona
- Rail and turnout grinding
- Routine civil, signal and electrical maintenance
- Station upgrade works at Erskineville, St Peters and Yagoona
- Vegetation maintenance, litter, and graffiti removal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- **Work will take place around the clock from 2am Saturday 13 August until 2am Monday 15 August.**
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains will be kept on site and may be idling for extended periods.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty throughout the works to assist motorists and pedestrians.
