City Circle to Ashfield track maintenance

From Friday 9 December to Monday 12 December 2022

What we're doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney Trains will complete maintenance works around the City Circle and Ashfield from Friday 9 December to Monday 12 December.

At Central Station, Sydney Metro is:

- Working within the hoardings on Platforms 16-23, the Eastern Suburbs Railway Concourse and the upper and lower Northern Concourse
- Installing services throughout the station
- Installing services, lifts, escalators and finishes for the metro platforms (underground former Platforms 13-15 area)
- Reinstating Platforms 13 and 14, including canopies (former Platforms 13-15 area).

Sydney Trains construction and maintenance works include:

- Bridge painting works at Flying Junction flyover's Central
- Drainage cleaning at various locations
- Level crossing upgrade works at Redfern
- Maintenance works at Redfern and Stanmore Train Stations
- Railway track defect removal to improve network reliability
- Railway track inspection and preventative maintenance
- Railway track and turnout resurfacing
- Railway track steelworks and grinding activities
- Railway track rerailing works at Central
- Routine engineering, signal, and electrical maintenance
- Railway track trefurbishment at Central
- Vegetation maintenance, litter, and graffiti removal.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night.
- Work will take place around the clock from 11.50pm Friday 9 December until 2am Monday 12 December.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
- Final (finishing) works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will use local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
