Clifton embankment remediation

From Wednesday 3 August to Wednesday 30 November

What we're doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking remediation works at Clifton from Wednesday 3 August to Wednesday 30 November.

To improve embankment stability, we will be:

- Install diameter piles
- Shotcrete between piles on the eastern side
- Construct capping beam on top of piles
- Install traffic barrier and handrails
- Install horizontal drain on the embankment
- Reshape and revegetate the embankment
- Construct new drain on North Bound shoulder of Lawrence Hardgrave Drive
- Reinstate access road and boundary fence.

We understand this work will have an impact on you and your neighbours. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the construction period.
- Work will take place from 6am to 5pm during weekdays from Wednesday 3 August to Wednesday 30 November.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.

Traffic and Parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor wherever possible, however please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near the worksite.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorist and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
