Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is rolling out new technology to upgrade Sydney's rail network and introducing modern signalling as part of the Digital Systems Program.

The Program will replace current signalling and train control technology with modern, internationally proven, intelligent systems. It will help improve reliability and increase capacity on Sydney's railways once implemented widely across the network.

Upcoming works

Various work will continue in November along the Sutherland to Cronulla rail corridor during standard hours – **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm** and **Saturday 8am to 1pm**.

Weekend work – Saturday 19 November to 20 November 2022

From 6am – 6pm Saturday 19 November and 6am – 6pm Sunday 20 November, works are planned during a scheduled Sydney Trains weekend possession.

Work activities will include new installation and maintenance works as well as testing of signalling infrastructure.

Additional construction work involving excavators may also take place at some locations within the corridor during standard work hours between **8am and 1pm on Saturday 19 November**.

The work in your area will not be continuous. Every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and to reduce impacts to the community wherever possible.

What equipment will be used?

Equipment will include hand tools and construction vehicles.

What you may notice

TfNSW is committed to minimising noise impacts on the community. The use of trucks to deliver machinery, equipment and materials may also occur outside of standard work hours to ensure the safety of the community and our workers.

We switch off equipment when it is not being used, place equipment as far away from properties as possible and monitor our work activities to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively.
