

Doonside Station Upgrade

Construction update | October 2022

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Doonside Station as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure, and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.

What we've achieved

- All reinforced concrete work for Lift 2 (providing future access to Platforms 1 and 2) has been completed including the base, walls, and landing.
- 50% of the new canopy footings on Platforms 1 and 2 have been constructed.
- 80% of the new inground station service routes have been completed.

Work continuing

In October, work at the station continues **Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm, and from 8am until 1pm on Saturdays** and will include:

- refurbishing inside the station buildings
- piling, civil, concrete and steel work to construct the new lifts and canopies
- making structural repairs to the footbridge, ramps, and stairs
- modifying the existing station toilet to become one family-accessible toilet
- excavating and trenching on Cross Street, Eastwood Lane, and School Parade
- tree trimming and vegetation removal
- landscaping and upgrading the footpaths and roads around the station.

How the work may affect you

- **At times there will be periods of high noise:** equipment used will include generators, trucks, gurney, circular saw, jack hammers, crane, compactor, excavators, and various hand and power tools. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible, including turning equipment off when not in use and positioning equipment as far away from properties as possible.
- **Temporary parking removal:** at times, up to eight car spaces at the access gate on School Parade will be required to facilitate vehicle access. Additional temporary parking removal will also be required on School Parade close to the station entrance to allow for the construction of one accessible car space. This work is expected to commence late October. Please see the map on the next page.
- **Temporary closure of a section of Eastwood Lane:** access to the station via Eastwood Lane (from Illoura Place) will be restricted at times in October to allow for trenching for new services. Access to the station will be maintained via Doonside Road. Signage will be installed to notify pedestrians, and traffic control will be in place.
- **Increase in construction traffic:** construction vehicles will access the rail corridor via the access gate on School Parade. At times there temporary parking removal will be required to provide access and traffic control will be in place to safely manage the work area.

- The existing station toilet will remain temporarily closed until end October while we convert it into a new family-accessible toilet. Signposted temporary unisex toilets are available at either side of the station on Doonside Road and Doonside Crescent.

Out-of-hours work

There is no planned work outside of standard construction hours in October. Should the need for any out-of-hours work arise, affected residents will be notified prior to the work commencing.
