

## Doonside Station Upgrade

### September Community Notification

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Doonside Station as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure, and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.

### What we've achieved

- The base foundations for all four lifts have been constructed
- 70% of the footbridge refurbishments have been completed
- The new stairs on platform 3 and 4 have been constructed and installed

### Work continuing

From 1 September, work at the station continues and will include:

- resurfacing and regrading on all platforms
- refurbishing inside the station buildings
- piling, civil, concrete and steel work to construct the new lifts and canopies
- making structural repairs to the footbridge, ramps, and stairs
- modifying the existing station toilet to become one family-accessible toilet
- excavating and trenching on Cross Street, Eastwood Lane, and School Parade
- installing new power poles on Cross Street and Coghlan Crescent
- landscaping and upgrading the footpaths and roads around the station
- tree trimming and vegetation removal. Landscaping will be provided to replace trees removed, at the end of the project.

### How will the work affect you?

There will be excavation and trenching work for new services on Cross Street, Eastwood Lane, and School Parade, as well as upgrades to the footpaths and roads around the station. This work is being completed in stages so that access to the footpaths and roads can always be maintained.

Traffic control will also be in place to safely manage work areas. The work may result in noisy periods, and all reasonable measures to lessen the disturbance will be in place.

The **existing station toilet will remain temporarily closed** until October 2022 while we convert it into a new family-accessible toilet. During this period, signposted temporary unisex toilets will be available at either side of the station on Doonside Road and Doonside Crescent.

## Out-of-hours work

To maintain a high standard of safety and reliability across the transport network, Sydney Trains schedule track work outside of peak times. Sections of the tracks are closed to enable construction teams to work safely and efficiently while fixing and upgrading the track and surrounding infrastructure.

In September, some activities have been scheduled to coincide with a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when no trains are running; we will be working from **6am Saturday 10 September until 10pm Sunday 11 September**. All work is dependent on permits, weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Please note that the footbridge will be closed during this time. A free rail replacement shuttle bus will run from the bus stop on Cross Street to take customers to Doonside Road.
