

# Doonside Station Upgrade

## August Community Notification

The NSW Government is improving accessibility at Doonside Station as part of the Transport Access Program, a NSW Government initiative to provide a better experience for public transport customers by delivering accessible, modern, secure and integrated transport infrastructure across the state.

## Upcoming work

From 1 August, work at the station will include:

- piling, civil, concreting and steelwork for the new lifts and canopies
- demolishing existing stairs on Platforms 3 and 4, access can be made via new stairs
- resurfacing and regrading all Platforms
- refurbishing inside the station buildings
- modifying the existing station toilet to become one family-accessible toilet
- making structural repairs and refurbishments to the footbridge, ramps and stairs
- installing new power poles on Cross Street and Coghlan Crescent
- installing a project office site compound on School Parade
- landscaping and upgrading the footpaths and roads around the station
- delivering mid-week plant and machinery to the station - scheduled after the last train and before the first train the next day
- delivering concrete via Cross Street, Eastwood Lane and School Parade
- storing project materials and rail corridor access on Coghlan Crescent, School Parade, Rosenthal Street and Doonside Crescent, opposite Silvereye Court.

## How will the work affect you?

There will be excavation and trenching work for new services on Cross Street and Eastwood Lane as well as upgrades to the footpaths and roads around the station. Access to footpaths and roads will be maintained during this time.

There will also be some structural repairs and refurbishments to the footbridge and ramps, however this work will be done in stages so the footbridge can remain open.

Until **October 2022**, the station toilet will be temporarily closed while we convert it into a new family-accessible toilet. During this period, signposted temporary unisex toilets will be available at either side of the station on Doonside Road and Doonside Crescent.

## Out-of-hours work

Scheduling work outside of standard construction hours allows our team to complete activities safely.

We understand that this work may be noisy at times. We will do everything to lessen the disturbance including turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers for trucks used on site.

From **6am Saturday 27 August** to **10pm Sunday 28 August**, we will be working continuously at Doonside Station when trains are not in service.

All work is dependent on permits, weather and site conditions and is subject to change. We will let residents living close by know if any of this work changes.

Please note that the footbridge will be closed during this time and no trains will be running. As an alternative to the footbridge, customers can take the free rail replacement shuttle bus that will run from the bus stop on Cross Street to Doonside Road.
