



# Commuter Car Park Program Emu Plains

# **Community Notification | September 2022**

### **Project overview**

Transport for NSW is constructing a new commuter car park at Emu Plains Station to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments. The car park, which will be accessed via a new roundabout at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street, will provide approximately 750 additional commuter parking spaces.

### Progress update and upcoming work

The construction team has made use of the spell of drier weather to make progress on the car park. Major earthworks in the car park have been completed and the replacement of the first of three sections of water main took place in August.

The following work is planned to occur in September:

- drainage work
- kerb and footpath construction along Old Bathurst Road
- vegetation management including tree removal work
- construction of footpath and stairs at the eastern end of the new footbridge with pedestrian diversions in place from 31 August for approximately two weeks
- asphalting and landscaping in the car park

Work along Old Bathurst Road will require ongoing traffic management. Minor traffic flow changes will be made and as required, traffic controllers and signage will be in place for the safety of motorists and workers.

Equipment to be used will include excavators, road saw, rollers and compactors, tipping trucks, jack hammers, concrete mixers, asphalt machine, service vehicles, various delivery vehicles, mobile crane, generators, lighting towers for nightwork, elevated work platform and hand tools.

# Night work in September

Subject to approval, sections of Old Bathurst Road will be closed over two weekends – 17-18 September and 24-25 September, to carry out gas main protection and stormwater drainage work. Access to Smith Street will be maintained via Russell Street. Please note there is a low clearance of 4.5m at the Russell Street rail underpass.

Additional night work may be scheduled for late September for power supply upgrade work.


All work is subject to weather, COVID and site conditions and may change without notice. A further notification about night work will be provided to nearest residents and businesses before work starts.

#### **Construction hours**

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays. All work is dependent on weather, site conditions and COVID restrictions and may be varied without additional notice.
