Commuter Car Park Program

Emu Plains

Night Work Community Notification | 17 August 2022

Project overview

Transport for NSW is constructing a new commuter car park at Emu Plains Station to provide the community with more convenient access to public transport and reduce congestion on our roads. The project is jointly funded by the Australian and NSW Governments. The car park, which will be accessed via a new roundabout at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street, will provide approximately 750 additional commuter parking spaces.

Upcoming night work – Wednesday 24 August 2022

To enable the new infrastructure, a section of water main needs to be replaced, which will take place during the night of Wednesday 24 August. Work will start from **8pm Wednesday 24 August 2022** and is expected to finish by **5am Thursday 25 August 2022**. The work area is located on the eastern side of Old Bathurst Road to the immediate north of the new footbridge (see map overleaf).

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. Traffic on Old Bathurst Road will not be affected by this work.

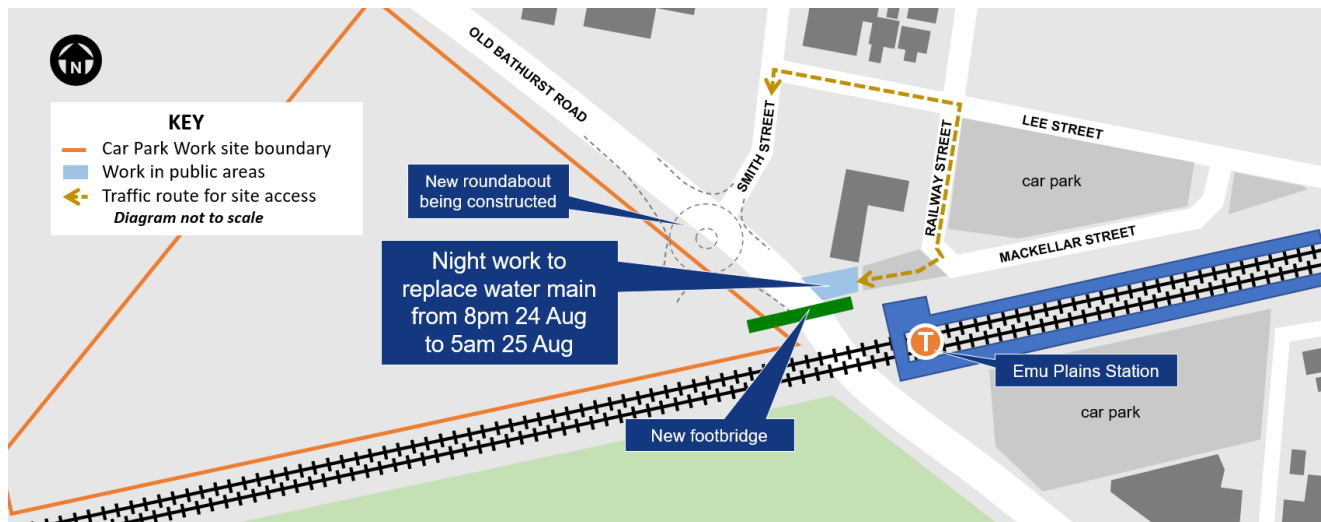
Sydney Water will provide further information to properties that may experience a temporary interruption to water supply.

Equipment to be used will include an excavator, lighting towers, diamond blade saw, ratchet gun, concrete truck, service vehicles, various delivery vehicles, and hand tools. Project vehicles will enter and leave the work site via Railway Street under traffic control.

All work is dependent on weather, site conditions and COVID restrictions and may be varied without additional notice.
