Planned out of hours work in October

In October, some activities have been scheduled at the same time as a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when no trains are running. Please be advised that other contractors will also be working during this period.

We will be working from **6am until 6pm Saturday 8 October and Sunday 9 October 2022.**

Activities will include:

- Excavating and trenching to install new services
- Installing new lighting and electrical upgrade work
- Installing canopy steel and roofing
- Improvements to the footbridges and staircases.

Work is subject to change. Please subscribe for email updates to receive more information about the location of work and specific planned activities, and also to be informed of any changes to our planned work scheduled. Please let us know if you require project updates via an alternative method.

How our work may impact you

- Measures to reduce noise will be implemented where possible.
- A work truck will be parked on Bridge Street during the weekend work period.
- There will be an increase in construction vehicles accessing our site, especially during the weekend work period.
- Traffic control will be in place to safely manage our work areas.

Day work in October

Day work in October will continue during standard construction hours (**7am until 6pm Monday to Friday, and from 8am until 1pm on Saturdays**).

This work includes:

- Lift measurements and fit-out work
- Canopy steel and roofing installation
- Bathroom upgrade work
- Electrical upgrade work
- Crane operations
- Excavating and trenching.
