What's happening in October?

Our work will include:

- installation of CCTV cables, kerbs, gutters, ramps, retaining walls and electrical structure
- stormwater drain and pipe installation
- surveying and investigation of existing services such as utilities
- excavation activities to remove soil, rock and other materials from site
- landscaping
- utility works along Peats Ferry Road including excavation, cable installation and overhead wiring modification.

How will our work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times. We have measures in place to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers for trucks used on our site.

The equipment used during the work will include vacuum trucks, excavators, surveying equipment, spoil removal trucks and hand tools.

Our work schedule

Our standard construction hours remain as Mondays to Fridays from 7am to 6pm and on Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

Alternative parking in Hornsby for Park and Ride commuters

Transport has renegotiated the alternative parking arrangement with Westfield Hornsby to continue to provide our customer with commuter parking on the purple of level of Westfield Car Park while we construct the new Hornsby Commuter carpark at Jersey Street.

Commuters can also access the existing car parks at George Street and High Street.
