What's happening in August?

In August, our work will include:

- bulk excavation
- · removal of existing asphalt
- electrical conduit installation
- stormwater drain and pipe installation
- survey and investigation of existing services
- installation of electrical infrastructure along Jersev Street
- demolition and construction of new pedestrian footpath at Jersey Street.

Temporary changes to parking

Our footpath upgrade work on Jersey Street will continue until late-August.

Around 22 on-street parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable while this work takes place.

Alternative parking will be available at Westfield Hornsby for commuter parking.

Our work schedule

Our standard construction hours remain from Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm and on Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

We will contact you to advise of any work required outside of these hours.

How will our work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, we have included measures to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers for trucks used on the site.

The equipment used during the work will include vacuum trucks, excavators, surveying equipment, spoil removal trucks and hand tools.


