### Ivy Street footpath widening

**From 7am Monday 9 January to 17 February 2023, Ivy Street will be temporarily closed to motor vehicles and all parking will be temporarily removed.**

The street will remain open for pedestrians and cyclists on the dedicated cycle path.

Traffic control and information signage will be in place to assist motorists, cyclists and pedestrians around the area.

Signage, barriers and traffic controllers will be in place to safely direct vehicles during construction.

### Parking changes

When the footpath widening is complete, parking on the western side of Ivy Street will be restored. Parking on the eastern side will be reinstated in coming months once further works are completed.

### What work is needed to widen the footpath?

The footpath widening will take up to six weeks to complete and will include the following activities:

- installing barriers and fencing for the exclusion zone
- protection of underground services
- excavation and asphalt removal
- formwork and concrete pouring
- kerb and gutter removal, and construction
- road re-surfacing.

The equipment needed includes jackhammers, excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, compactors, rollers, chainsaws, mulchers, elevated work platforms and hand-held machinery.
