

# Killara Station Upgrade

## Community notification – August 2022

Transport for NSW is upgrading Killara Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Work is progressing well at the station. During July we poured concrete for Lift 1, bringing all lifts to the height of the new footbridge. We also continued internal upgrades to the station platform building, including installing new level concrete floors for the public toilets and upgrading the station building sewer system.

### Upcoming work in August

Construction work at Killara Station will continue throughout August and will include:

- installing new high-voltage timber poles in the rail corridor
- further construction to the lifts on Werona and Culworth avenues
- paint blasting and repainting of the platform stairs
- structural repairs to the footbridge
- excavation and installation of cables to allow for electrical and power upgrades
- ongoing work on the station building and toilets
- concrete pouring for a new canopy on the station platform.

Equipment to be used includes compressor, dehumidifier, mobile crane, forklift, excavators, concrete, vacuum and delivery trucks, power, and hand tools.

### Weekend and night work

Weekend work will be carried out continuously at Killara Station from **10pm Friday 5 August** until **2am Monday 8 August**.

The activities will be taking place during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running.

For the safety of our workers, pedestrians and motorists, traffic diversions will be in place on Werona Avenue from **4am Saturday 6 August** until **6pm Sunday 7 August**. Please follow the temporary signs and traffic controller's directions.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and thank you for your understanding.

### Footbridge closure

Painting activities and structural repairs on the footbridge will continue in August. To allow for this work to take place, the footbridge will be closed between **4am Saturday 6 August** to **2am Monday 8 August**. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians to alternate routes until the work is completed.

### Station amenities update

In July, temporary male and female toilets were installed and opened to the public. These temporary toilets can be found on the platform next to the current amenities block, and are accessible **Monday to Friday, from 7am to 5pm**.

Please note, the toilets in the amenities block will remain closed until late 2022 to allow for ongoing upgrade works to the station building and during the closure period, there will be limited Sydney Trains staff working at the station.

### Construction hours

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm, Saturdays**.
