# Killara Station Upgrade

#### **June 2022**

Transport for NSW is upgrading Killara Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Work is processing well at the station. During May, we completed part of the service upgrades on the station platform. We also placed concrete to the walls of Lift 2 on the station platform to align with the new footbridge, removed the old paint on the Werona Avenue side of the existing footbridge and repainted the footbridge.

#### **Upcoming work in June**

Construction work at Killara Station will continue in June and will include:

- concrete placement for the lifts on Werona and Culworth Avenues
- excavation and construction of a new electrical transformer pad
- internal upgrades to the platform buildings.

#### Night work in June

No night work is scheduled for June 2022.

### Temporary closure of station amenities

From Monday 30 May until late 2022, the bathroom amenities at Killara Station will be closed. Alternative amenities will be available nearby at Gordon and Lindfield stations.
