Transport for NSW is upgrading Killara Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Work is progressing well at the station. During August we continued internal upgrades to the station platform building, including carpentry for a new accessible public toilet and work on the station electrical and communications systems. Painting work and modifications to the new station lifts also commenced in August.

Upcoming work in September

Construction work will continue throughout September and includes:

- ongoing work on the station building and toilets
- backfilling the excavation area for new lift on Culworth Avenue.

Equipment to be used includes excavators, concrete, delivery trucks and powered hand tools.

Construction hours


Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturdays.
