- 135 additional commuter parking spaces
- three new accessible parking spaces •
- dedicated pathways connecting to the existing • footpath on the corner of Barclay Road and Perry Street
- lighting and wayfinding signage for improve safety
- provision for future electric vehicle charging spaces
- landscaping within the car park and fencing.

Finishing work

Customers may continue to see construction staff on site throughout October and November while minor finishing works such as Transport Park&Ride infrastructure (Opal operated boom gates), and other touch-up work takes place in the coming weeks.
